PROCESS

Nominations are due by Friday 3rd May, 2019 and will be assessed by a panel led by IELLEN CEO. Award recipients will be announced at a breakfast event following the IELLEN Annual General Meeting held at the end of May, 2019. Letters of recommendation or any extra material can be attached to the application form.

TYPES OF AWARDS AND CRITERIA

Please note that nominated young people must have lived, studied or worked in Stonnington, Port Phillip or Boroondara in 2018.

SBAT Student Award (School Based Apprenticeship/Traineeship)

A school-based Apprentice/Trainee that has demonstrated outstanding commitment, attitude, achievement, and/or successful employment outcomes in an apprenticeship/traineeship.

VCAL Student Award (Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning)

A VCAL student that has demonstrated outstanding commitment, attitude and achievement in the completion of a VCAL Certificate.

VET Student Award (Vocational Education and Training)

A VET student that has demonstrated significant commitment, skill development and achievement in their VET in schools program.

VCE Student Award (Victorian Certificate of Education)

A VCE student that has demonstrated outstanding commitment, attitude, and achievement in the completion of a VCE Certificate.

Youth Recognition Award

A young person (up to the age of 20) who has demonstrated a significant contribution to their community, peer group or program and/or who has demonstrated success in the pursuit or attainment of their goals.
