- Helping provide access to education, training and employment opportunities.
- Connection of young people to existing services and support.
- · Assisting to prepare for living on their own.

 Subject to or has been subject to a Child Protection Care by Secretary Order.

OR

 Subject to or has been subject to a Child Protection Family Reunification Order.

SKILLS FIRST RECONNECT

Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) support people to enter further education, training or employment by:

- Providing access to tailored pre-accredited training to increase and support goals.
- Assessing client's learning and non-learning needs and career goals to develop an agreed learning plan.
- Providing support services that will help clients start and stay in training.
- Assisting students in transitioning to employment or further training.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Ages 17 19 years not completed year 12 or its equivalent (Cert II), OR
- Ages 17 19 years have been unemployed or under employed for more than 12 months, OR
- Ages 20 64 who are long term unemployed who don't have Year 12 or equivalent certification, and have been long term unemployed for 12 months or longer. AND
- · Australian citizen or permanent resident.
- Can be a visa holder with Bridging visa Class E or Safe Haven enterprise Visa or Temporary Protection Visa.
