Employer of the Year

A business or organisation that has employed at least one young person (up to the age of 20 years) during 2019 and/or provided other benefit(s) to at least one young person, and has a business or organisation located within Stonnington, Port Phillip or Boroondara.

Community Impact Award

An individual (20 years and over), group, program, initiative or an organisation that has made an impact in improving education, training and/or employment outcomes for young people (aged 10 to 20), with a focus in Stonnington, Port Phillip and/or Boroondara.
